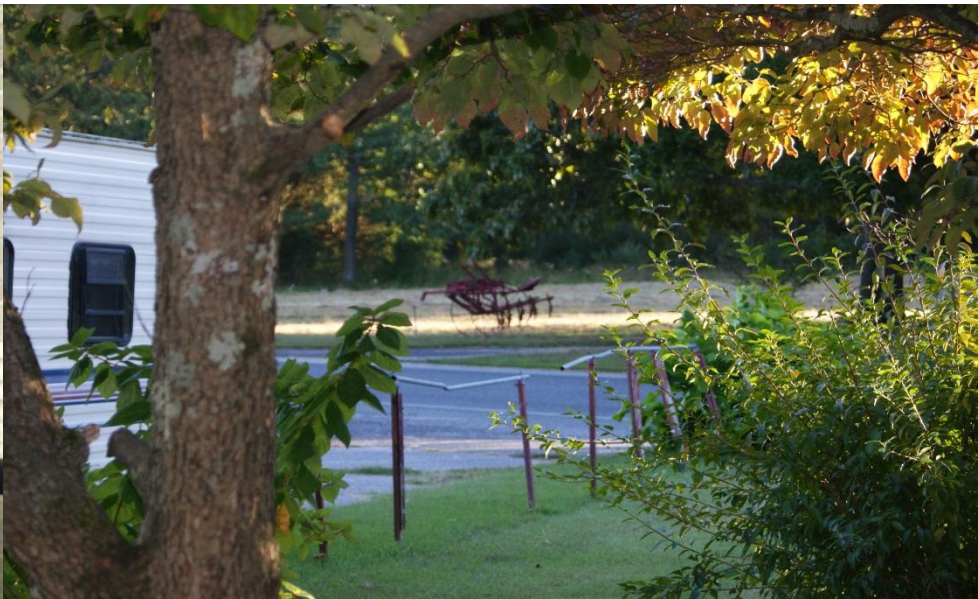


WEEKLY PHOTO ASSIGNMENT

Motion

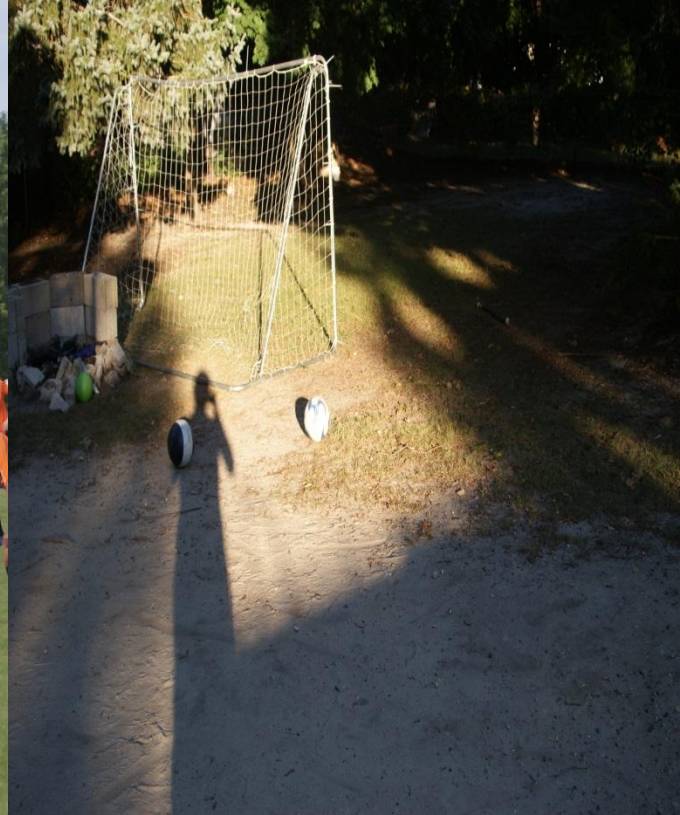
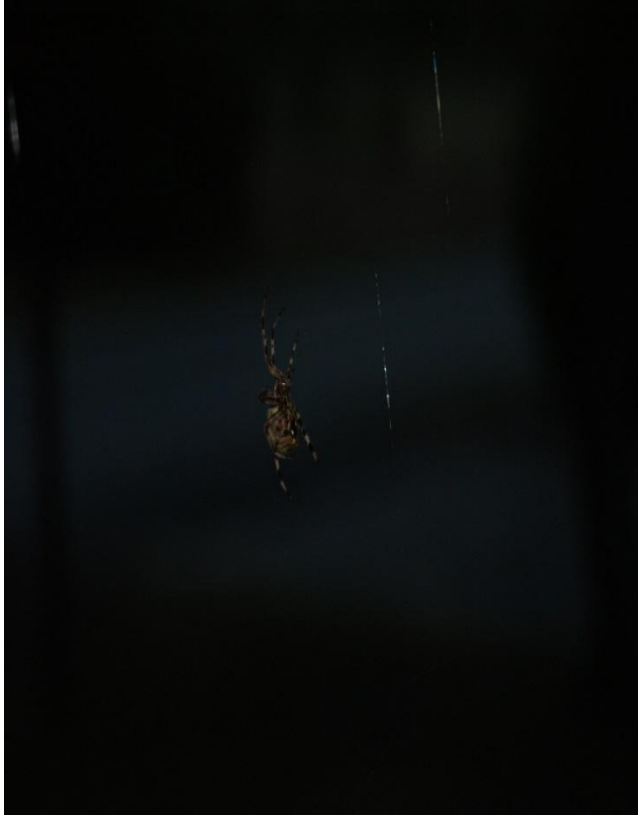
